Our Recruitment Process

Key steps in the recruitment and selection process are:

- Application form sent
- Application returned and assessed by RN
- Assessment of suitability to register by our trained recruitment team
- Interview booked at suitable, convenient location
- Confirmation letter sent detailing further documents required at interview including: Criminal Records Bureau Enhanced Disclosure and Disclosure Scotland checks, Equal Opportunities monitoring form
- Ex-Offenders and confidential Health Declaration form along with training record sent
- Referees contacted in writing and references followed up
- Interview conducted by recruitment RN with specialist recruitment and selection training
- Application processed, necessary checks carried out (occupational health, NMC/HPC Registration, manual handling, basic life support, CRB etc.)
- Registration subject to satisfactory interview, references, occupational health clearance, CRB Disclosure, NMC/HPC Registration and up-to-date training and skills
- Induction pack issued, including ID badge, induction booklet, company
